Teacher Assignments

Meet and Greet Day

This is when students and parents visit the school to meet their teachers, submit forms, drop off supplies and collect any necessary information. See the breakdown of schedules below.

K Day Meet and Greet - Monday, August 4 - Kindergarten students and their parents are invited to attend (please no siblings).

11 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. Group A (the teacher will send an invite with the student's time)

1 - 2:15 p.m. **Group B** (the teacher will send an invite with the student's time)

Drop Off/Carpool

The first day of school is Wednesday, August 6. All K-5 students should be dropped off in the carpool line between 7:15 and 7:45 a.m. Parents of elementary students arriving after 7:45 a.m. will have to park in the visitor lot and walk their children to the MAIN entrance to sign them in for the day. Classroom instruction begins at 7:50 a.m. <u>Parents may not walk their child to class during this time</u>. Staff will be available to assist students as they enter school. We will ensure that all students reach their classrooms and have a great start to the day. Carpool maps and carpool numbers will be provided in the Back-to-School Packet given to each student on their scheduled Meet and Greet Day. We will extend grace for the first two weeks of school as our school community acclimates to the flow of carpool.

Kindergarten Students Have Half Days the First Week of School

Please note that kindergarten students attend for a <u>half-day</u> during the first week of school,

Wednesday, August 6 - Friday, August 8. Dismissal on these days, for *kindergarten students only*, will begin at 11:45 a.m. from the elementary side of the building (across from the Junior Academy building). This serves several purposes - it eases the students into the routine, shortens a long day and allows us to train them in carpool procedures.

All kindergarten students will stay a full day starting Monday, August 11.

This modified schedule is for the first week of school only.
