You and your child are invited to meet his/her teacher on Monday, August 4, from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. At this time, you may bring the signed Junior Academy (JA) Intake and School Policy Commitment Form, Lillio Contract, JA Information and an updated copy of your child's Immunization Record. You may also bring all of your child's school supplies.

- 2. <u>Lillio Contract</u> Print, sign and return by August 4.
- 3. <u>JA Information</u> Print, complete and return by August 4.

Arrival Procedure

School begins on Wednesday, August 6, 2025. Our building requires drop off procedures that differ from previous years. Parents will carpool to the front of the JA Building where they will help their child exit the vehicle. Children will then be escorted into the building by staff members. The carpool map, which will be shared at Meet Your Teacher on August 4, shows the route for accessing the JA carpool line.

Please make every effort to have your child here by 8 a.m. when the JA carpool line

closes. Parking will be limited. For the safety of all children on the first day of school, the JA hallways will be for staff and students only.

Dress Code

Junior Academy students are encouraged to wear everyday play clothes. Girls must wear modesty shorts underneath dresses.

Footwear: Closed-toe, closed-heel-style shoes, standard athletic shoes or indoor boots with rubber soles (NO HEELS) should be worn. Velcro fasteners are preferred.
