

Epinephrine Pens

All Epinephrine pens for Elementary students are stored in the Health Room. These are to be turned in the first day of school with a completed Medication Administration Release Form (link [HERE](#)). Epi pens must be provided in the original packaging with the physician's name, prescription, and dosage instructions label intact. All student allergy(s), including severity, must be specified on the Student Medical Information Form in FACTS Family Portal (link [HERE](#)).

The Health Room does not keep expired Epinephrine pens. You will be notified within 30 days of the listed expiration date on the pen. The Health Room does not store Epinephrine pens over the summer. Parents are responsible for picking up the Epinephrine pen by the last day of school, otherwise the pen will be disposed of.

Middle School and High School students are allowed to self-carry Epinephrine pens. All students self-carrying must have the proper section of the Student Medical Information Form in FACTS Family Portal properly filled out in regards to the allergy(s) and severity of it in relation to the Epinephrine pen (link [HERE](#)). The parent must also provide a signature in the space provided for liability purposes. The nurse must be made aware if your student will self-carry and where the student plans on storing his or her Epinephrine pen.

Inhalers

All rescue inhalers for Elementary students are stored in the Health Room. These are to be turned in the first day of school with a completed Medication Administration Release Form (link [HERE](#)). All inhalers must be provided in the original packaging with the physician's name, prescription, and dosage instructions label intact. Students are able to come use their inhalers as needed. They are also sent on all field trips with teachers. The Health Room does keep expired inhalers. You will be notified within 30 days of the expiration date. The Health Room does not store inhalers over the summer. Parents are responsible for picking up their student's inhaler by the last day of school, otherwise it will be disposed of.

Middle School and High School students are allowed to self-carry rescue inhalers. All students self-carrying must have the proper section of the Student Medical Information Form in FACTS Family Portal properly filled out (link [HERE](#)). The parent must also provide a signature in the place provided for liability purposes. The nurse must be made aware if your student will carry a rescue inhaler.
