



Varsity girls lacrosse finishes 2nd at Braveheart JV goes 5-0, wins its division

The varsity girls lacrosse team started last week with a dominant 18-3 victory over the North Oldham Mustangs.

The Centurions were again led by captain Bree Emerson, who scored seven goals on seven shots. Junior Saibrin DeLessio scored five goals and set up the Centurion offense with a team-high seven draw controls.

Over the weekend, the Centurions played five games in three days at the BraveHeart tournament hosted by Sacred Heart Academy.

The team started the tournament strong with a 10-5 victory over Colle-

Varsity track & field places well at all-comers meet

This past Tuesday the Centurions traveled to North Oldham High School for an all-comers meet, which included a reduced slate of events.

The Centurion boys team placed sixth overall, led by a number of strong performances.

Ethan Fitzgibbon placed fifth in the 800m, Samuel Moskovich and Elijah Dale placed fourth and sixth, respectively, in the pole vault. Ben Stotts took sixth in the shot put. The boys 4x100 relay of Moskovich, Nagy, Stoner, and Neuner placed fifth and the 4x400 relay of Beardsley, Dale, Melton, and Moskovich gutted out a third place finish.

The girls team earned another

high team placement, taking third place.

Taylor Touche and Ava Moore took second and third in the 100m, and Ella Mast placed second in the 100m hurdles. Kayleigh Burkhead and Evie Neher bagged fourth and fifth place in the 800m run. In the 1600m, Taylor Greenwell and Ava Ward earned points for the team with fifth and sixth place finishes, respectively. Megan Bobnar and Ella Mast placed in both the long jump (second for Bobnar, seventh for Mast) and the triple jump (third Mast & fourth Bobnar). Lena Hall won the shot put and Bethany Lo-

-renz took eighth place. The 4x100 relay of Touche, Duck, Smith, and Moore raced to second place and the 4x400 relay of Smith, Burkhead, Turuso, and Duck took fourth.

On Friday and Saturday, a select group of Centurions competed in the Eastern Relays at the University of Louisville.

The meet is widely considered to be one of the most competitive events in the area, drawing athletes from Kentucky, Tennessee, Ohio, West Virginia, Illinois, Indiana, and Missouri. To participate athletes must meet strict qualifying standards for their event.

Those qualifying and competing were as follows: Samuel Herbig (1600m & 3200m), Lincoln Noltemeyer (triple jump), Anabelle Plummer (1600m & 3200m), Megan Bobnar (long jump, triple jump), and Ella Mast (100m hurdles, triple jump).

The Centurions are just over a month out from competing in the 2A Region Three meet at Shelby County High School on May 21, then the 2A State Championship in Lexington on May 31, 2024 at the University of Kentucky.
