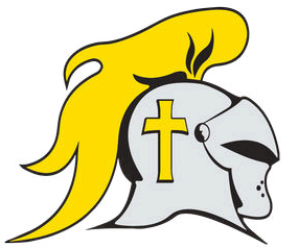

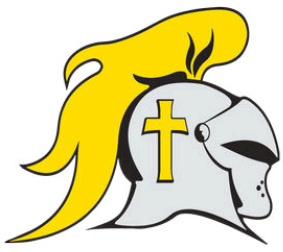

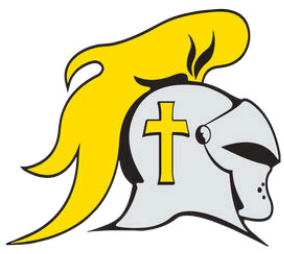


# Elementary Happenings...

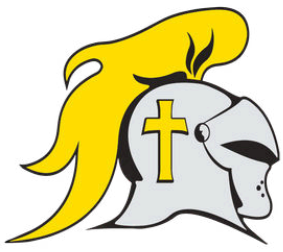


# Middle School Happenings...

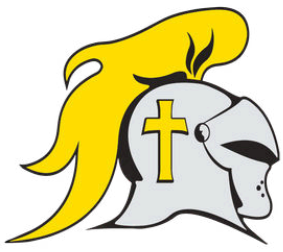


# High School Happenings...

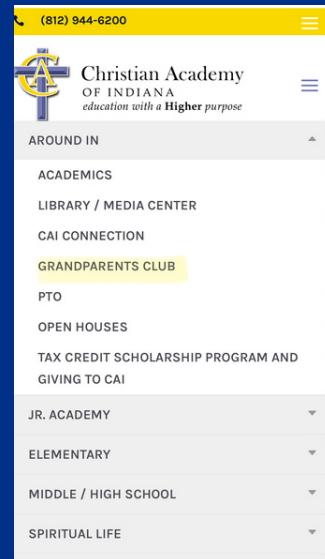

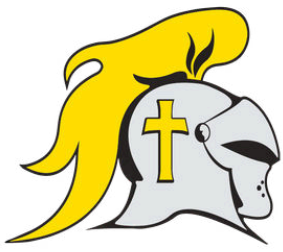
