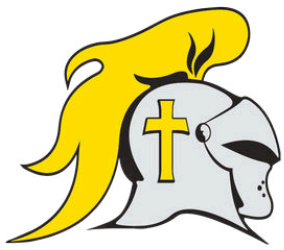

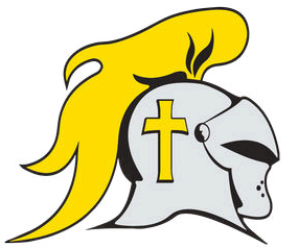

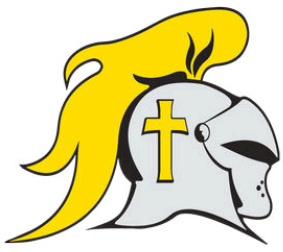


All-School Happenings...

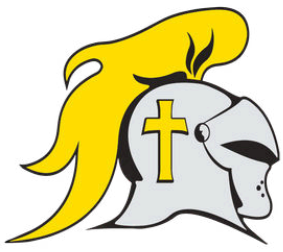


High School Happenings...

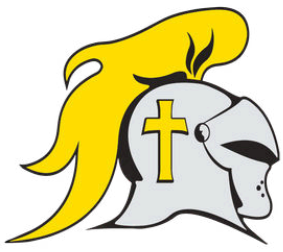
High School Happenings...

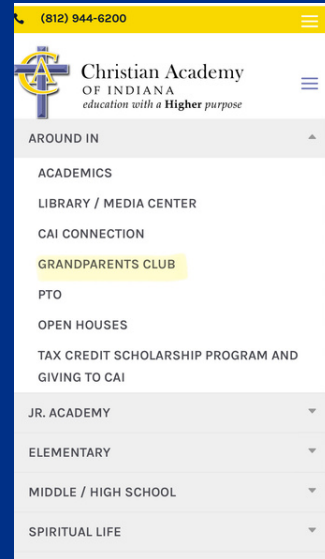

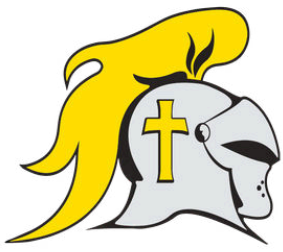
