You will need to create an account to apply. There are two separate applications. One is for the "General Scholarships" and the other is for the Lilly Scholarship.

The Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship will provide all funding necessary for awarding as many as two scholarships in both Clark and Floyd Counties. The scholarship provides full tuition to any four-year accredited Indiana college or university, public or private. Additionally, an annual stipend is awarded for books and required fees. The FSA ID — a username and password — has replaced the Federal Student Aid PIN and must be used to log in to certain U.S. Department of Education websites. Your FSA ID confirms your identity when you access your financial aid information and electronically sign Federal Student Aid documents. If you do not already have an FSA ID, you can create one.
