VARSITY CROSS COUNTRY

The Regional Championships turned out to be a very exciting day for the Warriors XC individuals that advanced to compete. With 25 teams and 75 individuals competing, that totaled nearly 250 competitors in each race.

In the first race of the day, Senior Alex Pinckney and Freshman Lincoln Birke represented CAI well. Alex qualified and will move on to the State meet with an 8th place overall finish. Lincoln Birke finished in 214th place as a Freshman, which is an incredible accomplishment and great experience for future seasons.

In the girls race, the Warriors qualified 4 runners for the Regional Championships. The team was led by Junior Anna Nash who finished in 119th place. Junior Madalynn Lutz and Sophomore Adeline Oakley finished nearly side by side in 189th, and 190th places respectively. Freshman Jillian McKain finished in the exact same placing as her fellow freshman Warrior Lincoln did in 214th place.

Overall, it was a great day with Alex moving on to the State meet, and everyone else getting great experience racing at the Regional Championship level.

Summary:

The Warriors finished out the regular season going 4-1 dropping a heavily contested five-set match at 2A Crawford County. The team finished with a record of 20-9. Heading into the postseason, the host Warriors had a bye in the first round of Sectionals. On Saturday morning they took on rival Rock Creek in the semifinals. The first two sets were a dog fight. The Warriors were able to pull away in the first set behind the serving of junior Kristen Abbott and the hitting of senior Karlyn Denny. The second set offered a more balance attack including contributions from senior Haley Jones (0.667 H%) and sophomore Maycee Hoefler (0.400 H%). The Warriors finished off the match with a decisive victory in the third set beating the Lion 25-10. The team then found themselves in their third straight sectional championship match; second in-a-row vs. Lanesville. Junior Kristen Abbott passed a team high 1.84. The offense was spread out pretty well on the night with all six of our hitters contributing five or more kills paced by Denny's 13 kills and Hoefler's nine kills. Sophomore Ella Peach led the team with 22 assists and Hoefler collected five blocks. Junior Avery Kerr had the task of defending both Rock Creek and Lanesville's top hitter. She held both of them under their season averages. Unfortunately it wasn't enough as the Warriors dropped the match 1-3.
